## Measles: What Doctors Need to Know?

### About the webinar

This webinar will be held on Zoom and is intended for medical practitioners.

**Background:** There is a global surge in measles with over 11 million cases in 2025. WHO reported over 42,000 confirmed cases in 2025 (compared to 8,000 cases in 2024) in the Western-Pacific region. Canada and the United Kingdom have lost their measles elimination status and the US saw 3 deaths from measles in 2025. Against this backdrop, CDA announced stepped-up public health measures for measles at the end of January.

This webinar is organised by the Communicable Diseases Agency (CDA), in conjunction with the National Centre for Infectious Diseases (NCID), the Academy of Medicine Singapore (AMS) Chapter of Infectious Disease Physicians, and the National University Hospital (NUH), Khoo Teck Puat - National University Children's Medical Institute (KTP-NUCMI).
