

Advanced Trauma Life Support Course

Introduction

Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS®) is an ACS Committee on Trauma educational program that provides a standardized, evidence-based approach to the rapid assessment and initial management of trauma patients.

Key Benefits

- Provides a structured method for evaluating and managing seriously injured patients.
- Establishes a common language and knowledge base for trauma teams.
- Promotes consistent, safe, and effective trauma care.

The course combines lectures and hands-on practical skills stations with simulated trauma scenarios to equip trainees with the knowledge and skills for resuscitation, stabilization and management of the acutely injured patient.

The course has been running since 2006 at Singapore General Hospital, and the faculty comprised of a select group of doctors from various specialities, each with a wide range of knowledge and experience in teaching. Our Centre trains about 100 participants each year.

Course Objectives:

The aim of the ATLS® course is to equip the trainees with the knowledge and skills for resuscitation, stabilization and management of the acutely injured patient through a systematic and concise approach to the early care of the trauma patient. The new edition of the Advanced Trauma Life Support® program—ATLS® 11 also promotes effective teamwork, trauma-informed care, clear communication, and injury prevention.

Target Audience:

This course is strongly recommended as a mandatory program for all surgical residents. It is also recommended for Medical Officers and any interested clinicians who seek to equip themselves with ATLS® skills, which provides a foundation of common knowledge for all members of the trauma team.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the course, trainees will be able to assess a patient's condition rapidly and accurately using a standard algorithm and recognize, prioritize, and manage life-threatening injuries. Trainees will also recognize when patient needs exceed local resources and require transfer.

Validation/Accreditation:

Upon successful completion, candidate will be ATLS® certified as set forth by the American College of Surgeons. Successful completion status is valid for 4 years from the course date. Singapore Registered doctors will also receive accreditation from Singapore Medical Council for Continuing Medical Education (8 CME Points).

How to Register?

Complete Registration Form and return via email. You will receive an email once your registration is confirmed.

Cancellation and Replacement:

Refunds will be issued if notice of cancellation is given in writing at least 8 weeks before the course date. A 10% administration fee will be charged. Cancellation of registration less than 8 weeks from course date is not refundable. In this situation, candidates are encouraged to nominate a replacement. No refund will be given after ATLS® student e-learning enrollment email has been sent. Candidates will receive e-learning enrollment email about 6-8 weeks before course dates.
